Croes Wilan junction – paint lines, thanks for cutting hedge. Near misses reported this month because of no road markings.

PUBLIC FOOTPATHS – bottom of school field, otherside of river – ground has become uneven, not safe for people who aren't steady on their feet

Bridle path gate above Foel Newydd – Gate is very dangerous

Bridle way opposite Stryd Ddu to Y Felin – overgrown

Cwm Fedw road, Rhiwsaeth Road - potholes

Drains need making accessible to the water Siamber Wen/ Pen Nebo area

Hirnant potholes – Gelli road and Rhiwsaeth roads and Stryd Ddu have big potholes – accident caused by the holes.

Dangerous drop on side of road where water has eaten into it at lay-by near Wern Ddu Fach, bollard is leaning, road needs reinforcing. Farmer has had to mechanically lift out a stranded vehicle from a 3ft hole. VERY DANGEROUS, potential for someone to be killed as drop is steep and long enough for a car to turn several times. The verge has grassed over beautifully so the dangerous, sheer drop is not visible at all. Not visible from a car. No edge to the road there at all.

Three bollards near Pentre Uchaf junction have been knocked over.

Penygarnedd Road – dangerous drop off edge of tarmac.

Bridge at Y Felin, Gelli bank Hirnant, wooden parapet – posts have rotted. Dangerous if leant on. Cable tied temporary barrier to the rotten parapet.

Subsidence between Cwmmwr and Ty Brith

Croes Wilan junction accidents and near misses are happening – stop sign is not very visible, junction warning sign missing coming from Pedairffordd direction. No white line, stop sign is not visible – hidden in hedge. Regular occurrence of cars not stopping, accidents have happened. The sign outside the bungalow obscures vision of tractors.

Telegraph poles on Pengarnedd road are leaning into the road – dangerous for tractors and lorries RESOLVED to report all issues ACTION CLERK Missing 30 sign on straight

Ask if they've inspected the Railway manhole cover yet and what action will be taken
