Farmer has had to mechanically lift out a stranded vehicle from a 3ft hole. VERY DANGEROUS, potential for someone to be killed as drop is steep and long enough for a car to turn several times. The verge has grassed over beautifully so the dangerous, sheer drop is not visible at all. Not visible from a car. No edge to the road there at all.

BACK ROAD TO Llangynog – flood, needs jetter

Bridge at Y Felin, Gelli bank Hirnant, wooden parapet – posts have rotted. Dangerous if leant on. Cable tied temporary barrier to the rotten parapet.
